

PatBase – New data, new machine translation, new search tools – search tips demo for the international, full-text patent family database from Minesoft and RWS, for existing users and newcomers

A workshop designed for new and existing PatBase users covering search and display features of this full text family based database.

Searching full text data from six issuing authorities combined with 4 major patent classification systems within a single database environment offers searchers greater possibilities from the start, however understanding the file structure is an important first step to formulating an effective search strategy.

The session will also introduce new features launched this year such as machine translations, new data coverage and advanced highlighting features. PatBase is a patent database covering data from 70 issuing authorities and has been designed for professionals by professional patent searchers.
