WIPO Patent Information Products – Latest Developments

Abstract

A core function of the patent system is the publication and dissemination of the technical information contained in patent documents, so as to make technology developments available to all. In this respect, the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) provides, through its PATENTSCOPE[®] search service (see <http://www.wipo.int/pctdb/en/>), access to the technology contained in around 1.6 million published international patent applications.

The seminar will provide an update on new and advanced features available on the WIPO PATENTSCOPE[®] search service, the world authoritative source of PCT international patent applications. Moreover, the possibilities of searching national collections on PATENTSCOPE[®] will also be explained in more detail.

This will be a good opportunity for participants to learn more about WIPO patent information services and products and to give feedback on their needs.
