LAVAZZA EXPRESSION

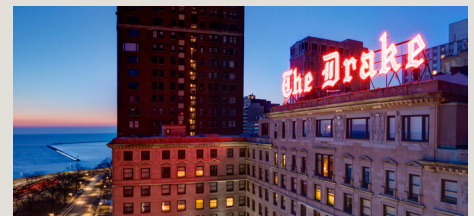
Serving espresso, cappuccino, and iced or hot coffee complemented by beautiful artisan pastries, sandwiches, and salads.
